About Christ the Light Ministries

1. Inspiration and Evolution of Christ the Light Ministries

The Church was established in April 2005 by Pastor George Awoyale (of blessed memory) with a vision of being a Church for all Nations. The focal point is soul winning and living a life of Faith in God and benevolence to mankind.

- 2. **Vision and Mission** Soul winning and spreading the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ to all nations in fulfilment of The Great Commission (Matthew 28: 16-20). To accomplish this we shall do the following:
 - a. Host worship and fellowship sessions where the Word of God is ministered
 - b. Groom Heaven-bound Disciples
 - c. Create an atmosphere of Christ love among our brethren
 - d. Reach out and impact our community through empowerment initiatives and expand to diverse areas through Mission programs.

3. Our Values

- a. **The Pursuit of God** We thirst for His presence and to know more of Him through private and public worship, the Word and prayer Psalm 42:1-2, 63:1-3; Matt 5:23; Luke 6:21
- b. **Character of Christlikeness** We want to be like the Lord and savior in all conduct. We want to minister by serving people the way He did with compassion, under the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit. We shall convey the love, mercy and power of God through the ministry of the church. Luke 14:16-20; John 20:21; Ephesians 5:2; Colossians 3:12
- c. **Godly Family Life** Where parents live as examples and cultivate an environment in which the spiritual, emotional and social growth of their children can be fully accomplished. Deuteronomy 6:7; Proverbs 22:6; 2 Timothy 3:15
- d. **Integrity in Ministry and Personal Life** Deal and conduct our affairs truthfully and honestly such that the gospel of Jesus Christ shall not suffer any reproach because of our conduct. 2 Corinthians 13:8; Ephesians 4:15, 5:9; 6:14; James 5:12
- e. Love and Unity in the Body of Christ We Love Unity in The Body of Christ. We agree with the scriptures that all who believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior belong to one body of Christ. We shall seek to maintain the unity with all such believers. Psalm 133:1; Romans 12:5; Ephesians 4:3-6,13
- f. **Modesty** We shall seek to be generous and gracious in our speech, firm in our convictions and decent in our dressing. Galatians 5:26; Philippians 2:3; 1 Timothy 4:14; 1 Peter 3:3-4; 1 John 2:15-17

- g. **Selfless giving and sharing** We shall always recognize in humility that all the goodness we receive from God is a result of His mercies, even those blessings we may regard as "rights" because of our relationship with Him as children. We shall therefore seek to extend mercy to another and to all who come under the ministry of the church. Psalm 52:8; Lamentation 3:22-23; Colossians 3:12; James 5:11
- h. **Church Establishment** The structure of Christ the Light Church is based on principle of accountability and orderliness in the execution of its events. Spiritual and administrative direction emanates from the Lead Pastors and is disseminated through instructions and/or delegation to the ordained Ministers and onwards to the workers and members (Romans 12).

4. Understanding of a Heaven-bound Disciple

Strangers in the Church are regarded as newcomers. As they develop spiritually, they begin to climb the hierarchical ladder, from the bottom. That is, newcomers become unbaptized members, then baptized members who become workers-intraining, then full-fledged workers. It is among the workers that Deacons, Deaconesses and Associate Pastors are chosen. This is in line with Scripture when Jesus Christ chose seventy disciples from Five hundred brethren; Twelve apostles from seventy disciples. Three - (Peter, James and John) from Twelve and one (John) from three.

Legacy Commendations

About the Founder, Pastor George Awoyale <u>His Early Life</u>

Rev. George Awoyale was born in Ghana where he lived his early childhood. His mother, being a devoted Baptist, showed him the way of the Lord very early in life. The family moved to Nigeria after his father passed on to glory.

His Career

He had his secondary school education in Benin City and subsequently studied Geology at The Polytechnic, Ibadan, where he graduated with Upper Credit honors. He later worked with the Nigerian National Electric Power Authority (N.E.P.A.) till he gained admission into a university in the United States in 1982, where he met his wife, Afolake, and they got married in 1991. He studied Business Administration at Jersey State University, New Jersey, and worked with the New Jersey State Social Services till he relocated to Atlanta in 2001.



His Walk with God

Rev. George was a vibrant Christian from his childhood. He would accompany his mother at 5.00 am to clean the church and prepare the altar for Daily Devotion (ipade adura ati eko Bibeli ojo'ojumo) at First Baptist Church, Ayeoba, Ile-Ife. They did the same exploit at Araromi Baptist Church, Oke-Obe, Iree. He also served as an Usher in all the churches he attended while living in Nigeria.



He gave his life to Christ and got born again while at The Polytechnic, Ibadan. He was a committed member of the Scripture Union, Nigeria in his student days and through his early working career. Upon relocating to the United States, he worshipped at Newark Gospel Tabernacle and rose to become an Elder and Minister. When he received the calling to start a Ministry, he relocated to Atlanta to establish Christ the Light Ministries in April 2005 starting as a fellowship in his family basement and expanded to a store-front worship center. The church eventually settled at Austell Road in Marietta, Georgia. His last assignment was to ordain some Ministers in the church committing them to the service of The Kingdom.

At his final moment when his wife asked him "what do we do concerning the Church? His response was absolute – "continue with the work of God". He passed

on to glory on November 14, 2009. He was blessed with four children, Ibukun-Oluwa, Ife-Oluwa, Igbagboleke and Ire-Oluwa.
